

Welcome to Writing on the Run!

System Requirements:

Requires a modern computer with a CD-ROM drive and Flash 9 Player and Adobe Reader version 5.0 (both free to download from [www.adobe.com](http://www.adobe.com/support/flashplayer/downloads.html) <http://www.adobe.com/support/flashplayer/downloads.html>). ,an Internet connection and current web browser. Best viewed on display with a set colour depth of minimum of 24 bits.

To Launch:

1. Drag file index.html onto an open browser window
2. If you do not have Flash Player 9 or later installed on your system launch the CD by double-clicking on the appropriate icon.

There are two ways to launch the CD:

PC users: Writing on the Run PC.exe

Macintosh users: Writing on the Run Mac.app

Problems Accessing the Print Tutorials and MLA Style Guide:

Accessing the PDFs and MLA Style Guide (in HTML) may present problems, due to how your system is set up. If you are having problems accessing these items from the CD interface, you can either;

- (a) open the interface by opening the file index.html
- (b) (described above) or access the files directly (described below).

Print Tutorials:

Included on this CD are print versions (PDFs) of the tutorials. To view these, you'll need Adobe Reader version 5.0 or later installed on your system (free to download from: <http://www.adobe.com/products/acrobat/readstep2.html>).

These tutorials are accessible through the CD interface; however, some people may have difficulties accessing them depending on how their system is set up to handle PDFs. If you cannot access the Print Tutorials from the CD interface, you can find them in a separate folder on the CD. Double-click the CD icon on your desktop and open the folder Print Tutorials to find the PDFs inside.

Navigating Information MLA Style Guide:

Depending on how your system is set up, you may have difficulties opening the MLA Style Guide from the CD interface. If you have difficulties, double-click the CD icon on your desktop. Then open the MLA Style Guide folder and drag index.html onto an open browser window.

Additional Troubleshooting Tips:

(a) Web Browsers

It is highly recommended that you perform a browser check to see if your computer is properly configured to use this media asset.

PC users: Microsoft IE 6.0 or later

MAC users: Mozilla Firefox 2.0 or later

(b) Pop-up Blockers

Some aspects of this interface utilize small browser windows to deliver requested content. Some pop-up blockers incorrectly interpret these small windows as pop-ups and block them. If you have installed a pop-up blocker, turn it off while viewing this media asset.

(c) Active XControl

ActiveX controls are currently limited to Windows environments. It is recommended you set your browser options to allow ActiveX controls while viewing this media asset.
