Five events from the play are listed below: for each event there is an incident and an outcome. In each event, the character(s) either acted or should have acted but didn't. Match the incident that initiated the event with the resulting outcome.

Incident	Outcome
A. Lord Capulet insists Juliet marry Paris.	____ Juliet takes her death to escape her impending marriage.
B. Mercutio defends Romeo and fights Tybalt.	____ Tybalt kills Mercutio.
C. Friar Laurence conducts a secret wedding, even though he knows Capulet and Montague won't approve.	____ Romeo and Juliet must keep their love hidden.
D. Friar Laurence doesn't get word to Romeo about his plan for Juliet.	____ Romeo breaks the law and returns to Verona to learn that Juliet has died.
E. Friar Laurence runs away from the tomb, leaving Juliet alone.	____ Juliet is abandoned and kills herself.
