

I – Part One	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • introduction • David and the speaker are working in the bush • “We climbed, to get from the ruck of the camp” and to exercise their young bodies (coltish muscles)
II – Part Two	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • first climb was Mount Gleam • “David showed me how to use the give of shale for giant incredible strides.”
III – Part Three	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rampart’s arête in the rain • “David taught me how time on a knife-edge can pass...” • they come across the skeleton of a mountain goat
IV – Part Four	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inglismaldie climb • “David taught me to read the scroll of coral in limestone...”
V – Part Five	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sundance climb was not successful • they found an injured robin (“David took and killed it, and said, ‘Could you teach it to fly?’”)
VI – Part Six	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the second attempt was successful • a day that filled their senses with fried trout and “sunhot raspberries” and deer and birds
VII – Part Seven	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • they finally climb “The Finger on Sawback” • David falls (“Without a gasp he was gone.”)
VIII – Part Eight	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bobbie, the speaker, climbs down to David • he whispered, “Bob, I want to go over!” • Bobbie deliberates what to do
IX – Part Nine	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bobbie manages to return to his work camp • he said that David “fell straight to the ice where they found him.”
