Also, if applicable:</li> <li>How does the music or soundtrack create suspense and emphasize emotion? Also, if applicable:</li> <li>How does the music or soundtrack emphasize emotion?</li> </ul>

Consider the characters	<ul> <li>Who are the main characters?</li> <li>What is their relationship to each other?</li> <li>What challenges do they face (personal, social)?</li> <li>Do they solve these problems?</li> <li>How do the characters change throughout the movie?</li> <li>Do other things in the movie change because of this society, social group?</li> <li>Are the characters and their situation believable?</li> </ul>

Consider the message	<ul> <li>What does the movie say about people and life?</li> <li>Does the movie present an optimistic or pessimistic view of life?</li> <li>Is the movie trying to present a social message?</li> <li>In the end, is this message presented directly, clearly, or has the director used symbolism or metaphor to get the message across?</li> </ul>
Evaluating Evaluate the movie	How well was the plot developed and suspense maintained?  How appropriate was the choice of cast?  What was the quality of the production—camera work, setting, cinematography, editing?  To what extent were you emotionally moved by the story? Why?
